Advisory “Ad Hoc Chapter 54 Committee” regarding recommendations for Amendments to Code Ch. 54 Parking

1. Appoint Chairperson

Sec. 2-101. - Ad hoc committees.

The town council, by resolution pursuant to the town Charter, section 3.15, may create ad hoc committees to advise the council on specific matters affecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the town or on matters relating to the operation of the town government. Any such ad hoc committee created shall exist for a period not to exceed 120 days unless the council approves a different term of existence... **At their first meeting, each committee shall appoint a chairperson to preside at each meeting.** Within 15 days after the last meeting of the committee, the committee chairperson shall submit a written report to the council with its findings and recommendations.

2. Discussion Items:

- a. Introductions – around the table self-introductions by:
 - i. Name; and
 - ii. Why you volunteered to serve on the committee
- b. Committee goals, objectives for recommendations to City Council;
- c. 120-day work plan,

3. Set future meeting dates and times

Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Town Council with respect to any matter considered at this meeting will need a record of the proceedings and for such purposes may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The law does not require the Town Clerk to transcribe verbatim minutes; therefore, the applicant must make the necessary arrangements with a private reporting firm and bear the resulting expense.
