1. Committee to elect a Vice Chair
 - Vice Chair must be member of the committee; Ben Crisp is not eligible as he is considered a town employee and committee resource.
2. Committee to approve Ch54 Committee meeting notes from 1/6 meeting.
3. Committee to review Section 54-111 (pg5) through Section 54-117 (pg9) to align on recommended edits.
4. Public comment only - not to include back and forth discussion between Residents & Committee members.
 - a. Each resident may be provided up to 3 minutes for comments, with residents' comment period not to exceed a total of 45 minutes.
 - i. Residents are to notate their intent to leave a comment on the check-in sheet, and the number of Residents in attendance will dictate the amount of time allowed for each Resident, sticking within the confines of a 45-minute comment period and maximum of 3 minutes per Resident.
 - b. Comment cards will be provided. Residents are encouraged to complete these alongside their oral comments.
 - c. Residents are asked to be respectful and adhere to the set comment period allotment based on number of Residents in attendance. Any disruptions will be handled accordingly.

Adjournment

Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Committee with respect to any matter considered at this hearing will need a record of the proceedings and for such purposes may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The law does not require the Town Clerk to transcribe verbatim minutes; therefore, the applicant must make the necessary arrangements with a private reporting firm and bear the resulting expense.
